



# CoDA Mixed Retreat at Sarum College, Salisbury

29th – 31st March 2019

Come and enjoy a weekend of CoDA recovery and fellowship at Sarum College, a beautiful and serene venue in the grounds of Salisbury Cathedral.

The retreat runs from 6pm on Friday until 3pm on Sunday and is open to men and women. Food and refreshments are provided. Accommodation is available on site in comfortable, modern bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms (as required). Day delegates are also welcome.

Dinner is served at 6.30pm on Friday, followed by the Welcome Ceremony. CoDA meetings take place all day Saturday and Sunday morning, with a social evening on Saturday.

Meeting sessions offer a choice of meetings including the 12 Steps, Chairs and a selection of topics which are agreed by delegates on Friday evening.

  - £50 Saturday (including lunch & dinner) **or**
  - £30 Sunday (including lunch)
